



Tabernacle Township teams up with the United States Coast Guard Auxiliary to offer a New Jersey approved Boating Safety course. All power boaters and personal watercraft operators are required to have a NJ State Police issued boating safety certificate on board while underway on NJ waterways.

This 8 hour course provides the “must know” on boating and personal watercraft topics such as:

- Things to know before leaving the dock
- Basic navigation
- Legal requirements – Federal and State
- Required & recommended equipment
- Trailering
- Boating emergencies

This course is approved by the National Association of State Boating Law Administrators and includes lectures, student workbook, handouts and testing to meet both Federal and NJ State requirements. Course instructors are experienced boaters of the US Coast Guard Auxiliary – the volunteer component of the United States Coast Guard. Upon successfully completing the course the US Coast Guard Auxiliary will process the required NJ State Police paperwork on your behalf. A temporary boating safety certificate is awarded at the completion of the course.
