“Gateway to the Pines”

Dear Tabernacle Township Residents:

Tabernacle Township Department of Public Works will be trimming back the roadways throughout the Township as weather permits.

This process will take a number of months to complete Township wide. This is required to provide safety on our roadways and in certain locations improves stormwater management and drainage control. The standard Department of Transportation (DOT) recommendation is trimming branches and limbs to a minimum clearance of 16 feet above the roadway.

The roadway will be trimmed so no branches or limbs protrude onto or over the asphalt portion of the roads to avoid obstruction of view and/or line of sight of an intersection or any traffic sign.

While roadways are being trimmed, any branches or limbs that remain a hazard to a pedestrian or bicyclist will be trimmed back to the main tree trunk in order to provide safety.

Please remember the Township has a right-of-way along the frontage of your property for utilities and drainage. The average width is 10 feet from the edge of the asphalt. However, it may vary due to the width of the road.

You may also trim your roadway frontage and contact us for review and approval. Should you have any concerns regarding your shrubs and/or existing plantings near the roadway, please email the Township at twpadm@townshipoftabernacle-nj.gov, with your contact information, address and concerns.

HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE

Household Hazardous Waste will not be collected by the Township at curbside. Residents are required to bring these items to the Public Works Facility only during scheduled collection dates and locations.

Household hazardous waste items include the following:

**Anti-Freeze - Batteries – Electric Ballasts - Finish Removers - Fluorescent Light Bulbs
Hydraulic Fluid - Kerosene – Oil – Paint – Solvents – Stains - Thinners**

ITEMS NOT COLLECTED

Asphalt pavement, branches and brush over 6 inches in diameter, block, brick, concrete, decks, fences, masonry, roof shingles, sheds, and oversized tires by nature of their weight and size will not be picked up or disposed of by the Township. The property owner shall make arrangements with a private company for their disposal.

TV RECYCLING

Computer towers, computer monitors, TVs and flat screen only are picked up on the **2nd Tuesday** of each month. Call Township at (609) 268-1220 to schedule a pick-up by 12:00 p.m. the day before. All items must be placed curbside by 6:00 a.m. the day of collection. We are unable to schedule same day calls for same day pick up.
